THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into on this the 16th day of July, A. D. 1931, between H. H. LATTIMORE and WILLIAM LATTIMORE, both of the City of Savannah, Georgia, as parties of the first part, and THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SAVANNAH, a municipal corporation in Chatham County, Georgia, as party of the second part,

-: W I T N E S S E T H :-

That said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar in hand paid to them by said party of the second part, as well as in consideration of the benefits to be derived by them by reason of the acquisition by said municipal corporation of the park and streets hereinafter described, hereby give, grant, bargain and convey unto said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, all their right, title, estate and interest in and to the following described property, to-wit:

All that part of Hull Park, owned by them, lying adjacent to the northerly line of the DeRenne Tract in Chatham County, Georgia, as shown on a plat made by Percy Sugden, C. E., on June 15, 1931, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and also all that part of Atlantic Street, owned by them, which bounds Hull Park on the east and south, as shown on said plat hereto attached and made a part hereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described part of Hull Park and the above described portions of Atlantic Street for park and street purposes, respectively, unto said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, forever, in fee simple.

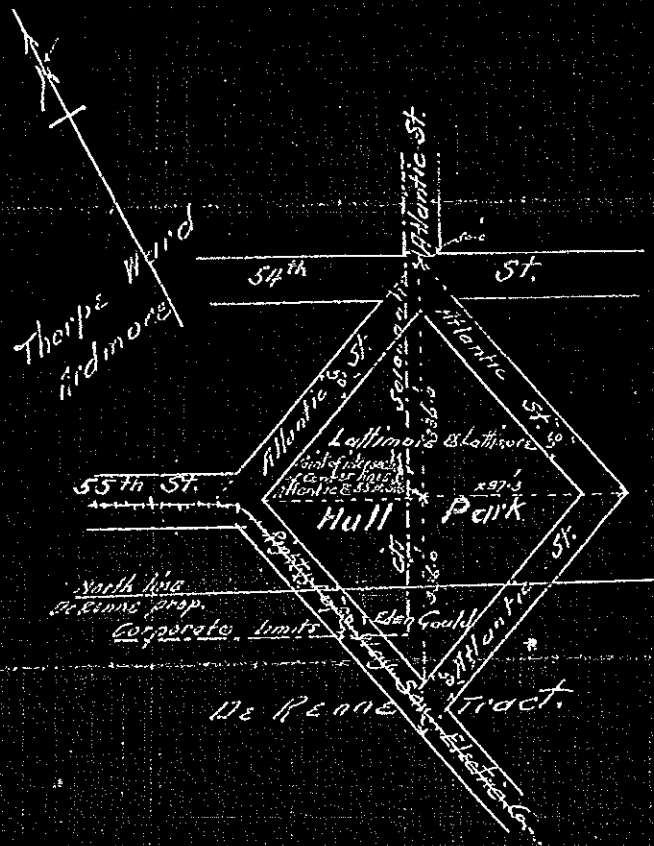
