the tract of land known as Hull Park lying within and
contiguous to the southeastern limits of the city as shown
on map of the subdivision, Ardmore, made by Percy Sugden,
C. E., and recorded in the office of the Clerk of the
Superior Court of Chatham County, Georgia, in Map Book
No. 2, page 38, more specifically described in the deeds
of gift hereby submitted.

The donors, Harry Hays Lattimore, William Lattimore,

will add much to the beauty of the southeastern residential
area of the city.

The plan of Hull Park and the arrangement of
Atlantic Avenue was approved by your honorable body in
the summer of 1925 at the same time that the plan of the
subdivision, Ardmore, was accepted. The deeds of gift
from H. H. and William Lattimore and Edwin Gould herein
enclosed have been properly drawn and executed.
