# 2022 Legislative Highlights

#### Savannah's 2022 Legislative Agenda

- Hotel Motel Tax
- Savannah Development and Renewal Authority
- Confiscated Weapons
- Workforce Housing

#### **Local Impacts of State's Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Budget**

- \$7 million for Savannah State University
- \$73 million increase for the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities
- \$80 million for Savannah Convention Center
- \$2.1 million Skidaway Institute of Oceanography

#### **Bills of Opposition**

- Gun Auction Requirement and Discharge within Cities
- Calculating Regulatory Fees
- Build to Rent Subdivisions

October 13<sup>th</sup> Draft Legislative Agenda provided to City Council

for prioritization

October 27<sup>th</sup> Legislative Agenda placed on City Council Agenda

January 9<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session Begins

February 9<sup>th</sup> Savannah Chatham Day
