

**RESOLUTION OF ADOPTION  
BY THE CITY OF SAVANNAH COUNCIL**

**WHEREAS**, St. Joseph's/Candler Health Systems' (SJCHS) President/CEO, Paul Hinchey, along with fellow SJCHS Leadership Executives, presented a \$15,000 donation to the Mayor and Aldermen for deposit into the Savannah Affordable Housing Fund (SAHF); and

**WHEREAS**, this is the sixth consecutive year that SJCHS has made a \$15,000 donation to the Mayor and Aldermen for deposit into the SAHF; and

**WHEREAS**, SJCHS' investment in the SAHF helps offer modest wage SJCHS employees with down payment and closing cost assistance necessary for them to become first time Savannah home owners; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Aldermen have determined that there is a need for local investment to address local workforce and affordable housing needs and opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Aldermen have encouraged banks, businesses, non-profits and other private entities to invest in the SAHF along with the City of Savannah; and

**WHEREAS**, the SAHF helps leverage private investment to address local workforce and affordable housing without using the SAHF to pay administrative costs; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Savannah Housing & Neighborhood Services Department and the Community Housing Services Agency, Inc. oversee administration of the SAHF.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah do hereby accept a donation of \$15,000 from St. Joseph's/Candler Health Systems for deposit in the Savannah Affordable Housing Solutions Fund.
