




Incident Command System

Festival Control Zone




- Wristbands

- Uber/Lyft Rideshare
- Increased Security
- Street Party Ends at Midnight



SPD Parade Operations

- Closures -
 - STAGING AREA 6 am
 - ROUTE (except Bay) 8 am
 - BAY Street 9 am
 - Trucks redirected at MLK
 - Cars allowed to park in Whitaker Garage
- Multi-agency collaboration
- Ambulance entry points along route
- No vehicular traffic on route
- Increased presence in squares









SPD Operations - Parade

- Parade is broken into 5 zones
 - Staging, Alpha, Bravo, Charlie, Delta
- SCMPD Traffic Unit handles parade movement
 - Will have officers leading and tailing parade
- Emergency Command Center (ECC) will coordinate public safety management / response
- Additional officers are already situated in the public parks / squares along the route
- Road Closure: Staging Area 6AM
- Road Closure : All Parade Roads 8AM




RED ZONE – RIVER STREET






BLUE ZONE – CITY MARKET




GREEN ZONE – PERIMETER



CITY MARKET COMMAND POST









Ambulance Safety Zone





- NO NIGHT COURT WILL BE OFFERED.
- SPD will use the <u>local ordinance citation</u> to cite persons for violating a local ordinance of the City of Savannah.
 - persons who reside outside of the Court's jurisdiction will be brought to CCDC (outside Bryan, Effingham, Liberty, Bulloch or Chatham County)
 - defendants will be booked and fingerprinted
 - charges will be entered onto the Recorder's Court docket
 - case file created
 - defendant will be brought before the presiding judge
 - judge will set cash bond and/or hearing for Not Guilty Pleas
 - Cash bonds will be posted with the S.O. at CCDC

Savannah Fire and Emergency Services

- City-wide Fire Protection
- Code Compliance/Fire Marshall (Festival)
- Fire Protection/First Response (Parade and Festival)
- 56 personnel will be hired on overtime to staff 2 Engines and 3 Rover units
- One engine and Rover will be staged at the west and east ends of River Street and one Rover staged at City Market
- One Battalion Chief per operational period assigned to the Unified Command Team
- Marine 1 Staffed for Dock Response/Water Ops/Rescue
- ECC Management





Traffic Engineering

- 300 Crowd Control Barricades Whitaker and Bay Streets
- 5 Changeable Message Boards for Bay Street Approaches
- 4 Changeable Message Boards Parking Information
- Pre-Stage Traffic Barricades 270 for parade / 65 for festival
- Install 60 Temporary Signs No Parking, Directional, etc.
- Traffic Management/Signal Control from ECC



Event Parking and Message Board Sign Locations

- (Yellow Highlight) Variable Message Board locations for inbound directions.
- (Red) Interstate-16 Eastbound/US 17/Talmadge Bridge Corridor (SR 25/SR 404 SP)
- (Blue) MLK, Jr. Blvd., Northbound
- 8-10 (Purple) W. Oglethorpe Ave., Westbound (SR 25 Connector)
- 11-12 (Green) W. Bay St. (SR 25 Conn.), Eastbound & Fahm St., Southbound
- 13 – (Orange) – Montgomery St., Northbound




Traffic Management/Signal Control from ECC



- Monitor traffic cameras
- Implement special traffic signal plans
- Adjust pedestrian signal timing based on crowds
- Receive, document, and dispatch barricade/street closure requests



Road and Traffic Management





Sanitation

- Stage Service Compactors and Commercial Containers to Supplement Compactors in Festival Area and Downtown for Parade Clean Up (Thursday)
- Stage Trash Cart / Recycle Bins Downtown (Thursday)
- Festival Cleanup River to Gaston (Friday Sunday)
- Clean Parade Route before and after Parade (Saturday)
- Remove Open Top Containers from Downtown Area and Service Compactors (Sunday)
- Street Cleaning will Clean Festival Area (under discussion with the changes in sweeping schedules) – Friday and Saturday
- Staff Landfill for Dumping (Saturday and Sunday)
- Remove Recycling & Refuse Cart Stations throughout Festival Area (Sunday)





Greenscapes – March 16th

- Routine service program for parks, squares and fountains
- Remove all temporary bollards from squares along route
- Rope off Liberty Street and Oglethorpe Avenue medians
- Rope off planting areas as necessary for protection
- Assist with setting up French barricades along parade route
- Inspect parade route and shut off irrigation





Greenscapes – March 17th

- Litter pickup and change out trash cans in Squares, Forsyth Park, north side Bay Street, South Side River Street
- Inspect fountains and touch up dye as necessary
- Break into three groups of three and report to Calhoun, Lafayette, and Chippewa for litter control during parade
- Inspect trucks, load equipment and go over procedures
- Mobilize to assigned locations for entering parade route
- Litter pickup and change out trash cans in Squares, Forsyth Park, north side Bay Street, South Side River Street
- Remove ropes from Liberty St. and Oglethorpe Ave. medians
- Break down barricades and store for next day pick up
- Inspect parade route and finalize any remaining services

Code Compliance Tasks

- Litter Control
- Illegal Dumping
- Compactor & Dumpster
- Proper Disposal of Trash (River Street)
- Mobile vendors: hawking, peddlers & street vending
- Fixed location vendors
- Tour Service Violations
- Taxi/Uber/Lyft Violations
- Permitted and illegal street performers
- Wristbands with SPD Support





Notification and Communication

5,000 Door Hangers will be placed on doors within the downtown area affected by the parade, as well as on vehicles in the area prior to event.

Both GPS tagging and photos from vendor will confirm placement.

Many streets along the parade route will be marked "NO PARKING - TOW AWAY" zones on March 17th from 12:01 am until as late as 4 pm. Please adhere to the signs posted; all zones WILL BE ENFORCED. A complete map of the parade route can be found at Savannahpd.org
