- 6. To prevent underage consumption of alcoholic beverages we have strict guideline on checking everyone's ID.
- 7. Being a convenience store we allow everyone to come to our establishment.
- 8. Being a high traffic area and to ensure everyone's safety we have fire extinguisher by the front door and around the bathroom.
- 9. In case of an emergency the staff is aware to guide people outside the building and call the emergency services.




