SUBJECT:	Zoning Review of Alcoholic Beverage License Request

In reference to the application of **Charles Hill Morris**, **T/A Kehoe Venues**, requesting an alcoholic beverage license at **660 East Broughton Street**, I have determined that the **Proposed Use**, **Assembly hall/Event venue/Catering service**, within the current **R-B-C Zoning District**:
