Nature of Request

The petitioner, Andrew S. Lynch as agent for Raghav Sapra., is requesting approval of a variance from the design standards of the Savannah Historic District (Section 8-3030(n)(7)) in order to install windows which do not replicate the original windows in composition.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends <u>approval</u> of the requested variance from Section 8-3030(n)(7) to permit the installation of double-pane windows at 7 Drayton Street.

Decision of the Board

Upon a finding that relief would not cause substantial detriment to the public good, or impair the purposes and intent of the Savannah Zoning Ordinance, a motion was made by Michael Brown and seconded by Willie James, the Savannah Zoning Board of Appeals adopts the following resolution:

Resolved, that the Savannah Zoning Board of Appeals does hereby <u>approve</u> the requested variance from Section 8-3030(n)(7) to permit the installation of double-pane windows at 7 Drayton Street, conditioned upon meeting any conditions set forth in 18-002685-COA.

Note:

No decision of the board of appeals permitting the use of a building or land shall be valid for a period longer than 12 months; provided, that wherever such use is dependent upon the erection or operation of a building, the board may extend the time for good cause thereon (§8-3165(e)).
