Background

- “Intergovernmental Agreement with Chatham County Pertaining to E-911 Center”
 - ✓ Approved by City Council on January 18, 2018
 - ✓ Stated “the City determined there is a shortfall in revenue”
 - Over \$2 million contributed annually from the City’s General Fund
 - ✓ County assumed financial responsibility effective January 1, 2018
 - ✓ County agreed to take over operations on July 1, 2018
 - Note: Effective date changed to January 1, 2019 (Council approved revision on June 7, 2018)

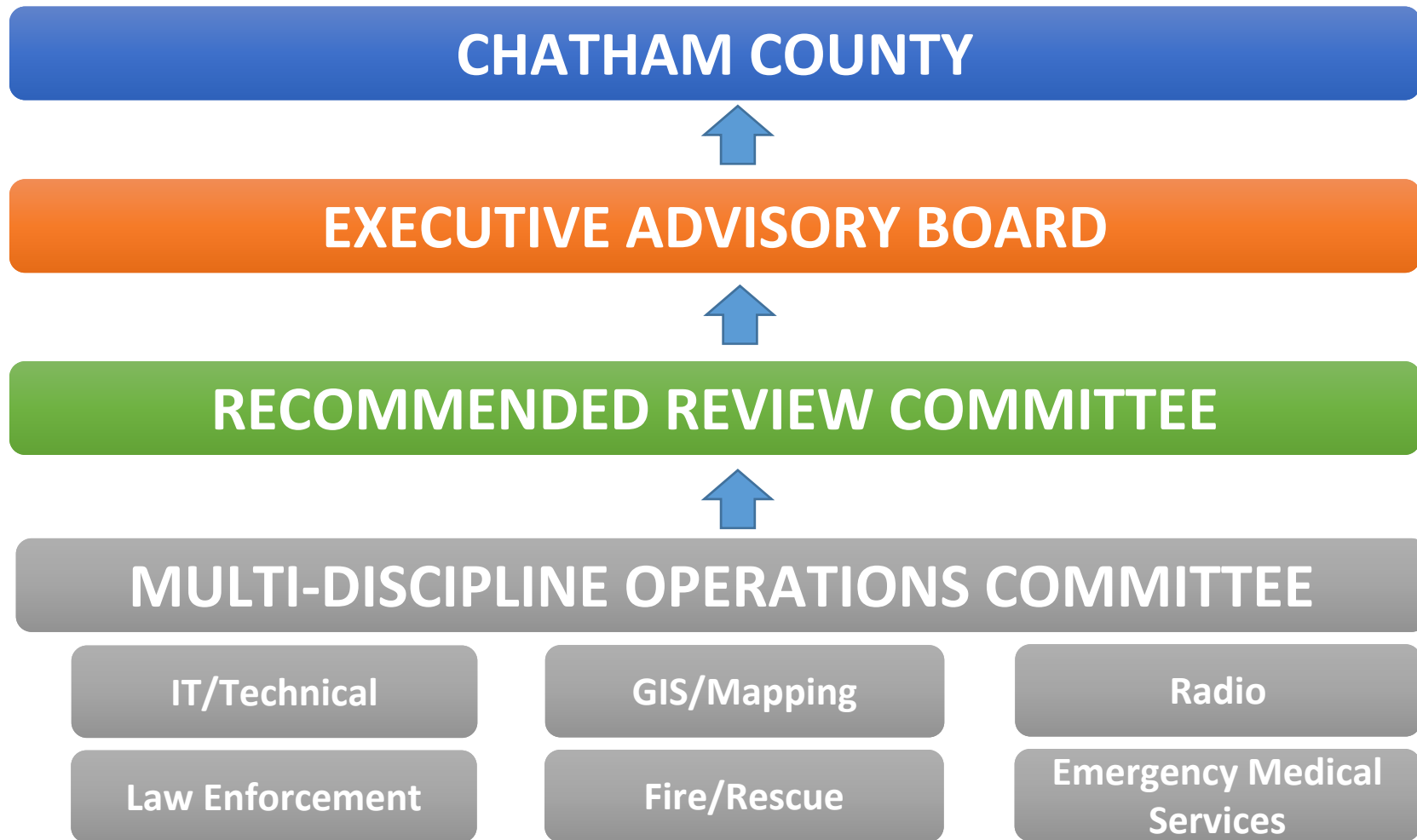


Background

- “Intergovernmental Agreement with Chatham County Pertaining to E-911 Center”
 - ✓ Agreement in effect for ten years unless mutual consent to change terms
 - ✓ County agreed to endeavor to agree and execute a mutually acceptable agreement pertaining to operations of County-wide E-911 Center

 - Georgia State Patrol



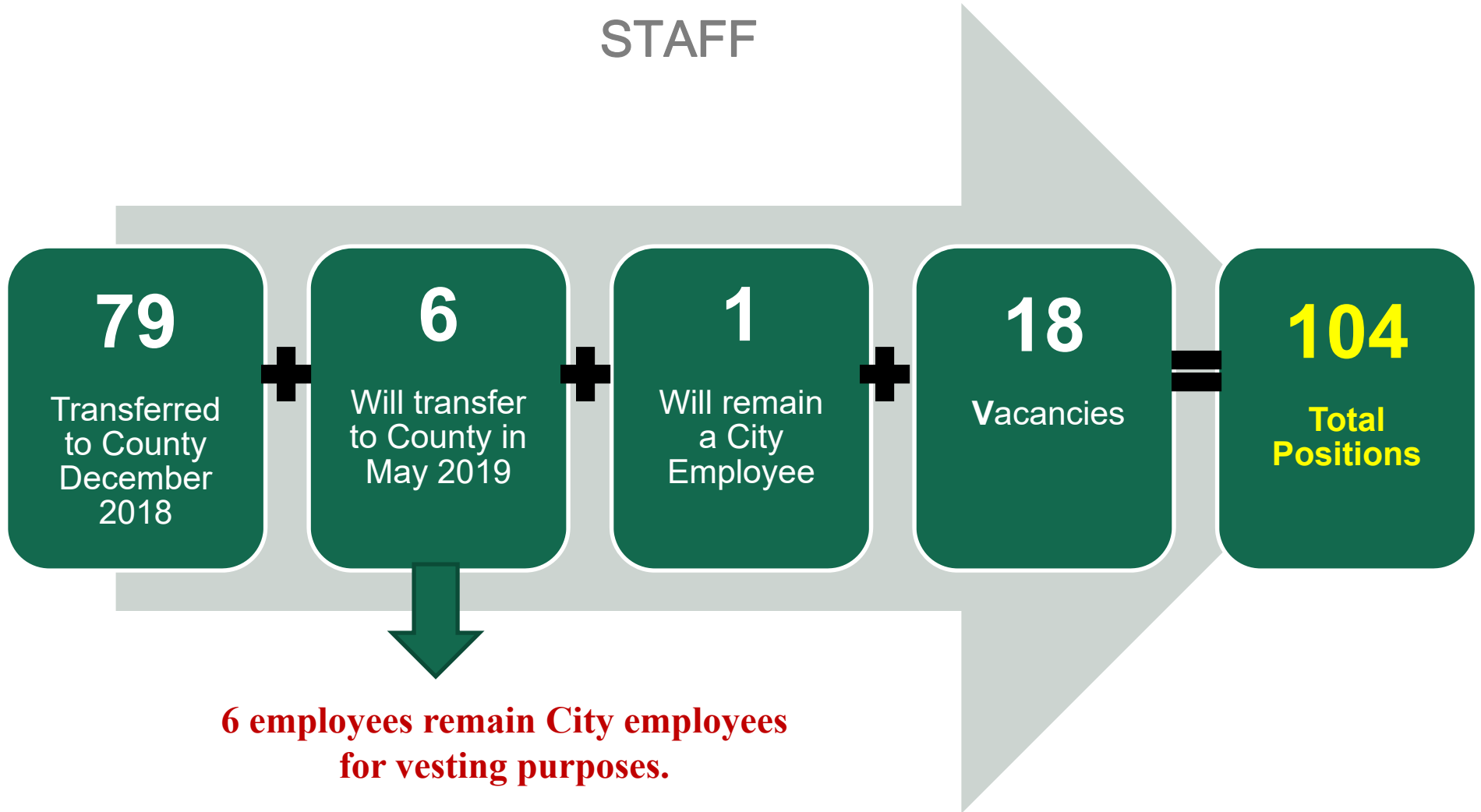
Current E-911 Governance Structure

- Recommendations Review Committee
 - Composed of Police Chiefs, Fire Chiefs and Department Heads
 - Provide recommendations to the Executive Advisory Board
- Multi-Discipline Operations Committee
 - Composed of E911 Staff, Operators (Law Enforcement, EMS, Fire Services and GIS) and others

911 Transition Status

- **Technology**
 - Migration of Police CAD systems from City servers to County servers occurred on December 18, 2018
 - Transfer of other systems were completed January 2019

- **Facilities/Operations**
 - Official name “Chatham 911 Communications Services”
 - Operations continue at the Chatham County Annex
 - Continued use of Civic Center as a backup facility
 - Currently searching for new Director
 - Position advertised January 10, 2019
