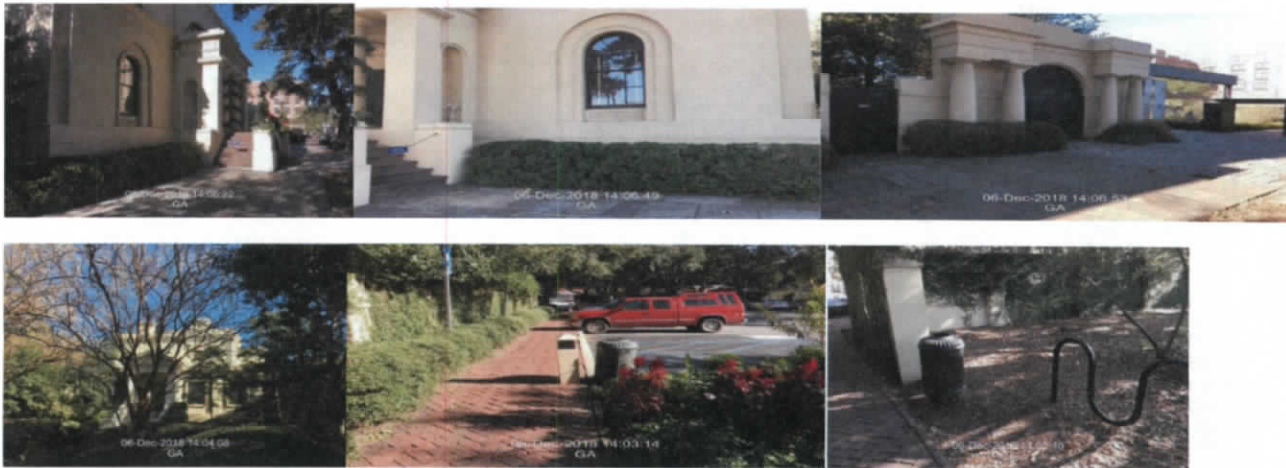

SUBJECT: Zoning Review of Alcoholic Beverage License Request

In reference to the application of **Charles Youles, T/A Ships of the Sea Maritime Museum**, requesting an alcoholic beverage license at **41 Martin Luther King Jr Blvd.**, I have determined that the **Proposed Use, Cultural facilities/Assembly hall that sells/provides/serves alcoholic beverages**, within the current **B-C Zoning District**:

- Is Not Permitted.
- Requires Special Use Approval by the Zoning Board of Appeals (ZBA).
- Is Permitted as a Nonconforming Use.
