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In reference to the application of **Pravin Patel, T/A Abercorn BP**, requesting an alcoholic beverage license at **7202 Abercorn Street**, I have determined that the **Proposed Use, Fuel Station with Convenience Store that sells beer and wine by the package/Ancillary Retail Package Store**, within the current **B-C Zoning District**:

- Is Not Permitted.
- Requires Special Use Approval by the Zoning Board of Appeals (ZBA).
- Is Permitted as a Nonconforming Use.
- Is Permitted with the Following Condition(s):
