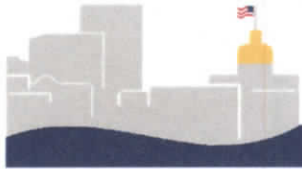

**SUBJECT:** Zoning Review of Alcoholic Beverage License Request

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In reference to the application of **Lauren Ashley Brooks, T/A Pounce Cat Cafe**, requesting an alcoholic beverage license at **404 W Broughton Street**, I have determined that the **Proposed Use, Restaurant that sells alcohol/Tavern/Bar/Cocktail Lounge**, within the current **B-C-1 Zoning District**:

- Is Not Permitted
- Requires Special Use Approval by the Zoning Board of Appeals
- Is Permitted as a Nonconforming Use
- Is Permitted with the Following Condition(s):
- Is Permitted by Right.**
