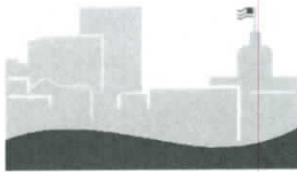
- Is Not Permitted


