

Nature of Request

The petitioner, Josh Yellin as agent for Starland Partners LLC (on behalf of Two Tides Brewing Co.), is requesting approval of a use, #8-3219(18) (Microbrewery), which may be approved by the Zoning Board of Appeals.

Staff Recommendation

The proposed use has been determined to meet the requirements of adjacency to a collector street or greater, as the Starland District is adjacent to both Bull and Whitaker streets. The use is limited to a modest production of malt beverage.

The petitioner is proposing to include seats and tables for patrons, and will operate the facility as a bar serving the malt beverage produced on-site.

Staff recommends approval of the proposed use #8-3219(18) (Microbrewery).
