The applicant shall address parking requirements prior to an appearance before Council. This office requires the submission of a site plan that depicts each existing vehicle parking space. The parking requirements are as follows dependent on the proposed principal use classification:

- 1. Bar; tavern: 47 off-street vehicle parking spaces
- 2. Restaurant: 36 off-street vehicle parking spaces
