Unfortunately, we do not have a report to upload because the applicant must provide proof the property meets the parking standards. Please note the information in the checklist, which states the following:

Notes:

The applicant shall address parking requirements prior to an appearance before Council. This office requires the submission of a site plan that depicts each existing vehicle parking space. The parking requirements are as follows dependent on the proposed principal use classification:

1. *Bar; tavern:* 47 off-street vehicle parking spaces
2. *Restaurant:* 36 off-street vehicle parking spaces

It is our recommendation that the petitioner wait until the parking is approved before going to Council.





The purpose of this memorandum is to submit recommendations effective 11/8/2022.
