

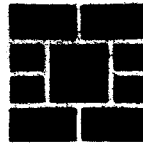

Re: Zoning Review of Alcoholic Beverage License Request 21-005749-ABL

In reference to the application of **Jacqueline Somesso, T/A Sloppee Toppee, LLC**, requesting an alcoholic beverage license at **416 W Liberty St**, I have determined that the **Proposed Use, Restaurant with Retail consumption dealer (on premise consumption of alcohol)** within the current **B-C Zoning District**:

- Is Permitted by Right:** The principal use classification *Restaurant* is permitted by right in the zoning district.
- Is Not Permitted.
- Obtained a Special Use Permit from The Mayor and Aldermen.
- Is Permitted as a Nonconforming Use.
- Is Permitted as a Limited Use with Standard(s):** The accessory use classification *Retail consumption dealer (on premise consumption of alcohol)* is permitted as a limited use with standards per Article 5 Sec. 5.4 Principal Use Table. Per Article 8 Sec. 8.7.24(b)(i), the use is permitted by right, because the parcel is not within the boundaries of an Alcohol Density Overlay District. The standards are met.

Additionally, I have determined that the **Proposed Use**:

- Is an Existing use/occupancy, but new ownership, management or request.
- Is a new use/occupancy.**


Additionally, I have determined that the **Location**:

- Zoning Ordinance violations that need to be corrected prior to the issuance of the Alcoholic Beverage License.
- Does not have a recent Business Location Approval for the property.**


