

The purpose of this memorandum is to submit a recommendation effective 9/21/2022 regarding the petition of Mr. Christopher Dickerson for an Alcohol Beverage License at Squirrel's Pizza, to be located at 100 Port Street.

The petitioner is requesting a Class C (Retail Dealer) Classification 1/2/3 (Distilled Spirits, Malt Beverage, Wine) with Sunday Sales license for this establishment.

A review of the criminal history of **Mr. Christopher Dickerson**, to be found on file with the Alcohol Beverage Compliance Unit, revealed no disqualifying information as outlined in the City of Savannah Code of Ordinances, Section 6-1207, b. 6. The purpose of this memorandum is to submit recommendations effective 10/13/22. The following information is being supplied on an official basis concerning a new Alcoholic Beverage License for Mr. Christopher Dickerson. A security plan has been submitted by the applicant and reviewed by the Savannah Police Department.

The security plan was examined to ensure it properly addressed all mentioned concerns in the City of Savannah's Alcohol Beverage Ordinance, Section 6-1206, Subsection D, Paragraph 4, Items A-I (as applicable).

In reference to the petition for Mr. Christopher Dickerson requesting a Class C123 (Retail Dealer of On-Premise Consumption: distilled spirits, malted beverage and wine) and Sunday Sales permit at 100 Port Street, "Squirrel's Pizza Eastern Wharf", I submit the following:
