PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

To the Mayor and Alderman of the City of Savannah, Georgia:

- 1. The undersigned, being the sole owners of one hundred (100%) percent of the real property within the territory described herein, do respectfully request that the Mayor and Aldermen of Savannah, Georgia, annex the territory described below to the City of Savannah, Georgia, and extend the city boundaries to include the same.
- 2. The territory to be annexed is unincorporated and contiguous (as defined in O.C.G.A. §36-36-20) to the existing corporate limits of Savannah, Georgia, and the description of such territory is as follows:

Parcel One (1)

All that certain tract, or parcel of land situate, lying and being in Chatham County, Georgia, shown as a 556.1-acre portion of the Mrs. J. D. Blitch Tract (Blitch Tract No. 1) on a plat of survey dated January 16, 2007, prepared by Michael E. Stone, Georgia Registered Land Surveyor No. 2747, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A," said plat being incorporated herein by reference and being made a part hereof for better determining the metes, bounds, courses, and distances of the subject property, which are set forth on the attached Exhibit "A-1."




