

**RESOLUTION REGARDING DELEGATION
TO EXECUTE CEMETERY INTERMENT RIGHTS
AND PERPETUAL CARE AGREEMENTS**

WHEREAS, Section 3-110 of the City Charter vests authority and power to make and execute contracts in the City Manager; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-108(9) of the City Charter provides that the City Manager has the right to recommend to Council for its adoption such measures as he may deem necessary or expedient; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager considers the ability to delegate certain administrative functions vested by the Charter in the City Manager to executive level staff necessary and expedient to the administration of City affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Aldermen believe that this Resolution furthers the interests of the citizens of Savannah in ensuring fluid operation of the day-to-day affairs of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Aldermen reserve the right to revoke this delegation upon written notice to the City Manager, without more; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution will automatically expire, without further action by the Mayor and Aldermen, upon the current City Manager's death, resignation, termination, or incapacitation;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah, Georgia hereby resolve as follows:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to delegate the ability to execute cemetery interment rights and perpetual care agreements to the Director of Real Estate Services as he deems necessary and expedient. Such delegations shall be in writing.
