

**RESOLUTION OF ADOPTION  
BY THE CITY OF SAVANNAH CITY COUNCIL**

**WHEREAS**, Wal-Mart #4530 Store Manager, Steve Thomas, and Community Housing Services Agency, Inc.'s (CHSA) Executive Director, Anita Smith-Dixon, presented a \$2,000 donation to the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah (City) for deposit into the Savannah Affordable Housing Fund (SAHF); and

**WHEREAS**, the funds were secured by CHSA from Wal-Mart store numbers 635, 8202, and 4530; and

**WHEREAS**, this is the first year Wal-Mart has invested into the SAHF; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Aldermen have determined that there is a need for local investment to address local workforce and affordable housing needs and have encouraged banks, businesses, non-profits and other private entities to invest into the SAHF along with the City of Savannah; and

**WHEREAS**, the SAHF helps leverage private investments to address local workforce and affordable housing needs and opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, none of the donations or investments into the SAHF are used to pay administrative costs; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Savannah Housing & Neighborhood Services Department and CHSA oversee administration of the SAHF.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah do hereby accept a donation of \$2,000 from Wal-Mart for deposit into the Savannah Affordable Housing Fund.
