10	THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into by and between the SAVANNAH
11	AIRPORT COMMISSION, a public body corporate organized under the laws of the State of
12	Georgia, hereinafter called "Commission," and JOHNSON CONTROLS, INC. hereinafter
13	called "Vendor."
14	
15	WITNESSETH:
16	
17	WHEREAS, Vendor desires to provide to the Commission certain services for Access
18	Control to 16 IT Rooms located at the Savannah/Hilton Head International Airport at 400
19	Airways Avenue, Savannah, Georgia, hereinafter called "Premises";
20	
21	In consideration of the foregoing and of the mutual covenants and agreements herein
22	contained, Commission and Vendor do hereby mutually undertake, promise and agree, each for
23	itself and its successors and assigns, as follows:
24	
25	1. TERM
26	The initial term, hereinafter referred to as "Term," of the Agreement shall commence on
27	January 1, 2021 and shall continue until December 31, 2025. Upon completion of the initial
28	term, the Agreement will automatically renew on a year-to-year basis, unless either party gives
29	the other forty (45) days written notice not to renew or change the renewal terms.
30	A GCORE OF WORK
31	2. SCOPE OF WORK
32	a. The services to be covered under this Contract Agreement will be as provided in
33	Exhibit A, "Proposal," dated November 16, 2020, which is attached hereto and made a part
34	hereof.
35	b. The terms and conditions of the services and equipment provided by Vendor are
36	described in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
37	c. For repairs or work outside of the scope of this contract, Vendor shall receive
38	Commission approval prior to proceeding.
39	d. Unless otherwise authorized by the Commission, all work, service and repairs will
40	be performed during normal working hours, which shall be defined as Monday through Friday,
41	8:00 a.m 5:00 p.m. Only those holidays recognized by the Savannah Airport Commission will
42	be considered as outside normal working hours.
43	e. Vendor shall provide adjustment and/or repair callback service during normal
44	working hours.
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3. FEES AND CHARGES

In consideration of the services to be granted to Commission, the Vendor shall be entitled as compensation the following fees and charges for the initial term:

a. Fee for Vendor services and equipment is <u>Forty-Four Thousand</u>, <u>Five Hundred Two (\$44,502.00) Dollars)</u>, paid quarterly as Eleven Thousand, One Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars and 50/100 cents (\$11,343.75). Following the initial term, the compensation to be paid to the Vendor for remainder of the term, shall be as follows:

4. <u>INSURANCE AND INDEMNIFICATION</u>

- a. With no intent to limit Vendor's liability or the indemnification provisions set forth herein, Vendor shall procure and maintain during the term of this Agreement the following minimum limits:
- (1) <u>General Liability Insurance</u> no less than <u>One Million (\$1,000,000)</u> <u>Dollars</u> each occurrence, Combined Single Limit ("CSL"), bodily injury and property damage, including Employer's non-ownership liability, patent infringement and intellectual property rights protection, and hired auto coverages as applicable, which shall not be subject to cancellation or change until after thirty (30) days written notice shall have been given to Commission, as well as:
- (2) <u>Comprehensive Automobile Liability Insurance</u> \$500,000 for all owned vehicles, non-ownership liability, and hired vehicles; \$5,000,000 for all vehicles operated on the Aircraft Operations Area (AOA).
 - (3) Umbrella \$5,000,000 (covers all liability lines).
- (4) <u>Worker's Compensation</u> in compliance with Georgia Statutory Limits, including an All States Endorsements.
- b. Vendor must maintain on file in the Commission office during the term of this agreement an original signed copy of Vendor's Certificate of Insurance reflecting the above limits and naming the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah and the Savannah Airport Commission, its directors, officers, employees, and agents <u>as additional insured</u>, and shall be delivered to Commission by Vendor within ten (10) days of request by Commission.

c. Indemnification

Vendor shall protect, defend, and indemnify Commission and its officers, agents and employees from and against any and all liabilities, losses, suits, claims, judgments, fines or demands arising by reason of injury or death of any person, or damage to any property, including all reasonable costs for investigation and defense thereof (including but not limited to attorney fees, court costs, and expert fees), of any nature whatsoever arising out of or incident to this

Agreement and/or the use or occupancy of the Commission or the acts or omissions of Vendor's officers, agents, employees, Vendors, sub-Vendors, licensees, or invitees regardless of where the injury, death or damage may occur unless such injury, death or damage is caused by the sole negligence and the willful misconduct of the Commission or any of its officers, employees, Vendors or agents. The Commission shall give to Vendor reasonable notice of any such claims or actions. The Vendor shall also use counsel reasonably acceptable to Commission in carrying out its obligations hereunder. The provisions of this Section shall survive the expiration or early termination of this Agreement.

d. All insurance polices shall contain a standard cross-liability provision and shall stipulate that no insurance held by Commission will be called upon to contribute to a loss covered thereunder. Commission shall have no liability for any premiums charged for such coverage, and the inclusion of Commission as an additional insured is not intended to and shall not make Commission a partner or joint venturer with Vendor in Vendor's operations on the Premises. Such policies shall also insure Vendor against the risks to which it is exposed as the Vendor of the business authorized under this Agreement, shall be for full coverage and shall contain provisions on the part of the respective insurers waiving the right of such insurers to subrogation.

5. MISCELLANEOUS

a. Personal Liability

No member of the Commission or employee of either party shall be charged personally or held contractually liable by or to the other party under any term or provision of this Agreement because of any breach thereof or because of its execution or attempted execution.

b. Non-Waiver of Rights

No waiver or default by the Commission of any of the terms, conditions, covenants, or agreements hereof to be performed, kept, or observed by the Vendor shall be construed or act as a waiver of any subsequent default of any of the terms, covenants, conditions, and agreements, herein contained to be performed, kept, or observed by the Vendor, and Commission shall not be restricted from later enforcing any of the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

c. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be deemed to be made in and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Georgia and that venue of any action brought hereunder shall be exclusively in the County of Chatham.

d. Permits, Licenses, Miscellaneous Fees

The Vendor shall pay all expenses in connection with the performance of this service and maintenance agreement herein and the rights and privileges herein granted, including without limitation by reason of enumeration, taxes, including ad valorem taxes, permit fees, license fees, and assessments lawfully levied or assessed and that Vendor will secure all such permits and licenses. Failure to pay said taxes and/or fees shall be considered an event of default under the term of this agreement.

e. <u>Binding Agreement</u>

The terms of this agreement are the exclusive and binding agreement between the parties hereto covering the services set out herein. No change, modification or revision of this agreement shall be valid unless agreed in writing and signed by both parties. Each party acknowledges participation in the negotiations and drafting of this Agreement and any

1	modifications thereto, and that, accordingly, this Agreement will not be construed more				
2	stringently against one party than against the other.
