

**RESOLUTION OF ADOPTION
BY THE CITY OF SAVANNAH COUNCIL**

Whereas, the Cory Joseph Wilson Memorial, Inc. donated six automated external defibrillators (AEDs) to the Savannah-Chatham Metropolitan Police Department; and

Whereas, an AED is used when a person is experiencing sudden cardiac arrest; and

Whereas, an AED can check the person's heart rhythm and determine if the individual needs an electric shock to restore a normal rhythm; and

Whereas, Cory Joseph Wilson, a Savannah native, died in 2013 due to a cardiac arrhythmia while in class at Georgia Southern University. There was no AED nearby at the time; and

Whereas, in Cory's memory and in order to help others in need, friends and family organized the Cory Joseph Wilson Fireball 40 Memorial Baseball Tournament which helps Cory's family and friends present AEDs to Chatham County and other nearby locations; and

Whereas, the Savannah-Chatham Metropolitan Police Department will have the AEDs available in each police precinct and the training unit;

Whereas, the six AEDs are valued at approximately \$12,000;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the City of Savannah Council does hereby accept the six donated AEDs from the Cory Joseph Wilson Memorial, Inc. to help provide life-saving aid to our officers and citizens
