

**RESOLUTION OF ADOPTION  
BY THE CITY OF SAVANNAH CITY COUNCIL**

**WHEREAS**, Memorial Health University Medical Center (Memorial Health) presented a \$30,000 donation to the Mayor and Aldermen for deposit into the Savannah Affordable Housing Fund (SAHF); and

**WHEREAS**, this is the third consecutive year that Memorial Health has made a donation, investing a total of \$90,000, into the SAHF; and

**WHEREAS**, Memorial Health's investment into the SAHF helps offer their modest wage employees and team members with down payment and closing cost assistance to help them become first time Savannah home owners and assistance to residents living in neighborhoods near Memorial Health improve housing conditions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Aldermen have determined that there is a need for local investment to address local workforce and affordable housing needs and opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Aldermen have encouraged banks, businesses, non-profits and other private entities to invest into the SAHF along with the City of Savannah; and

**WHEREAS**, the SAHF helps leverage private investments to address local workforce and affordable housing needs and opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, none of the donations or investments into the SAHF are used to pay administrative costs; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Savannah Housing & Neighborhood Services Department and Community Housing Services Agency, Inc. oversee administration of the SAHF.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah do hereby accept a donation of \$30,000 from Memorial Health for deposit into the Savannah Affordable Housing Fund.
