SPECIFIC SPECIFICATIONS AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR EVENT# 2794 – DRIVE TRAIN COMPONENTS

4.0 The purpose of these specifications is to establish an annual contract for the purchase of replacement parts and services for drive train components for medium and heavy trucks.

To submit pricing electronically for this event, enter pricing for each line item shown under the lines tab on the event summary. To enter pricing manually, complete the attached bid proposal form. If submitting electronically, submit the total amount for each line item as the materials cost (\$50,000) minus the percentage discount. For example, if your discount is 65% you would enter \$17,500 as your total discounted cost.

A pre-bid conference has been scheduled to be conducted at the Purchasing Office, City Hall, third floor, 2 East Bay Street, Savannah, Georgia. This meeting will allow contractors to discuss the specifications and resolve any questions and/or misunderstandings that may arise with City staff. You are invited to attend.

4.1 Specifications

- **4.2** The successful vendor will provide new or manufactured parts that meet or exceed original equipment manufacturer standards.
- 4.3 All parts required under this contract are for vehicles under repair. Therefore, delivery time is critical. The City reserves the right to make purchases from vendors other than the contract vendor. This shall be on a case-by-case basis when the Vehicle Maintenance Department Director deems the contract vendor's time to be unacceptable.
- 4.4 All parts represent typical, heavy usage items being purchased on a repetitive basis. Prices must remain firm for the life of the contract.
- 4.5 Percent differentials from the manufacturer's list price (MPL) shall be submitted for the items and manufacturers shown on the bid proposal form. The percentage discount offered will be from the published retail list price sheet. A copy of the current sheet must be provided with this bid submission. No consideration will be given to bidders who fail to submit current price sheets with their bid. Also, any subsequent price sheets issued during the term of the contract must be provided at least ten (10) days prior to the effective date of the new prices. The percentage discount from the price sheet must remain firm for the duration of the contract.
- 4.6 Additional purchases will be required for parts not covered on the bid proposal form. Pricing of these items, along with aftermarket or re-built parts, should be consistent with the lowest pricing offered by the vendor.



- 4.7 This contract will cover new components, rebuilt components, and repair parts. All repair parts provided must meet or exceed the specifications and performance of the original component part. In case of a dispute, it will be the vendor's responsibility to prove that their item meets or exceeds specifications.
- 4.8 It will be the responsibility of the selected vendor to provide the City of Savannah with the latest design replacement part. Parts which require modification to the component are not acceptable unless they represent a design change by the original manufacture or approved in advance by the Vehicle Maintenance Director.
- 4.9 All prices should be FOB 6900 Sallie Mood Drive, Savannah, Georgia 31406. Unit prices should include all delivery and handling charges.

5.0 Insurance Requirements

5.1 Comprehensive General Liability

Contractor shall carry comprehensive general liability on an occurrence form with no "x, c or u" exclusions with the following minimum limits:

- Each occurrence \$1,000,000
- Damage to Rented Premises \$50,000
- Medical Expense \$5,000
- Personal & Adv Injury \$1,000,000
- General Aggregate \$2,000,000
- Products Completed Ops. Aggregate \$2,000,000

General aggregate shall apply on a per project basis

Contractor will provide a Certificate of Insurance reflecting required coverage.

A waiver of subrogation endorsement to the policy in favor of the City shall also be provided and attached to the certificate

A (30) day notice of cancellation in favor of the City must be endorsed to policy and attached to the certificate

5.2 Commercial Automobile Liability

The automobile policy must include coverage for owned, non-owned and hired automobiles

- Minimum limits are \$1,000,000
- Contractor will provide a Certificate of Insurance reflecting required coverage.



- A waiver of subrogation endorsement to the policy in favor of the City shall also be provided and attached to the certificate
- A (30) day notice of cancellation in favor of the City must be endorsed to policy and attached to the certificate

5.4 Workers Compensation

Contractor shall carry a workers compensation policy including all statutory coverage required by Georgia state law

Minimum employers liability limits:

- \$500,000 each accident
- \$500, 000 each employee (disease)
- \$500, 000 policy limit (disease)

Contractor will provide a Certificate of Insurance reflecting required coverage.

A waiver of subrogation endorsement to the policy in favor of the City shall also be provided and attached to the certificate

A (30) day notice of cancellation in favor of the City must be endorsed to policy and attached to the certificate

5.5 Umbrella/Excess Liability

Contractor shall carry an umbrella/excess liability policy which must follow form over underlying policies: general liability, auto liability and employer's liability.

Minimum limits: \$1,000,000 per occurrence \$1,000,000 aggregate

Contractor will provide a Certificate of Insurance reflecting required coverage.

Waiver of subrogation endorsement to the policy in favor of the City shall also be provided and attached to the certificate

A (30) day notice of cancellation in favor of the City must be endorsed to policy and attached to the certificate

5.3 General

All insurance shall be placed with Georgia admitted carriers with a current Best's rating of A(minus), X, or better



Any modifications to specifications must be approved by the City

- **6.1** The bid response must include the following documents in this order:
 - Bid Proposal Form
 - Non-Discrimination Statement
 - Proposed Schedule of MWBE Participation
 - Other requested submittals as stated

All referenced documents must be completed and returned in their entirety to constitute a complete bid.

- 6.2 Bids may be submitted manually to the address listed in the bid documents or electronically via the supplier portal in sufficient time to ensure receipt by the Purchasing Department on or before 1:30 P.M. on the date specified in the web page listing for this event. Requested documentation may be attached to the bidder's response. - 6.4 Vendor is responsible for determining and acknowledging any amendments issued in connection with this bid solicitation.
- 6.5 To submit and be awarded a bid, vendors must be registered as suppliers on the City of Savannah's website at www.savannahga.gov.
- 6.6 This is an annual contract and prices are to be held firm for a period of one (1) year (12 months). This agreement may be renewed for up to four (4) additional twelve (12) month periods, if all contracting parties so agree and services provided by the vendor have been satisfactory.
- 6.7 Bonding: (Check where applicable)
 - [] (A) Each bidder shall post a bid bond, certified check or money order made payable to the City in the amount of 5% of the bid price. A company check is not acceptable. No bids shall be read or considered without a proper form of security.

Developing a Strong M/WBE Participation Plan

Key facts every bidder/proposer needs to know <u>prior</u> to developing their M/WBE Participation Plan:

- All bidders/proposers must submit a "Proposed Schedule of M/WBE Participation" which identifies the minority and/or womanowned companies that have agreed to participate in the project if awarded. All companies listed on the form must be <u>certified</u> as either <u>minority</u>-owned and controlled or <u>woman</u>-owned and controlled. The City does <u>not</u> accept a company's "self-identification" as minority or woman-owned.
- 2. <u>Proof</u> of M/WBE certification from the certifying agency is <u>required to accompany the bid</u>; and certification must have been completed by the City of Savannah, a federally-recognized or a state-level certifying agency (USDOT, State DOT, SBA 8(a) or GMSDC) <u>utilizing certification standards comparable to</u> the City of Savannah.
- 3. The certification must have been approved <u>prior</u> to the due date of this bid. A firm that has submitted an application for certification but has **not** been certified will not be counted toward the M/WBE goal.
- 4. The M/WBE Office will be contacting all M/WBE firms included in the bidder's M/WBE Plan to confirm each: a) was contacted by the bidder/proposer; b) performs the type of work listed; and c) agreed to participate.
- To expedite the verification process, bidders/proposers need to: provide accurate phone numbers for all M/WBEs listed; ensure M/WBEs know to expect to be contacted by phone and email; request M/WBEs be accessible during the critical period before bid-opening; and advise M/WBEs that City staff <u>must</u> receive the M/WBE's confirmation that the firm agreed to participate in the bid/proposal in order for the prime contractor to receive credit toward their proposed M/WBE participation goals.
- 6. If a proposed M/WBE cannot be confirmed as certified, performing the type of work described <u>or</u> agreeing to participate, the bidder/proposer will be notified and given a pre-determined period to submit a correction. If an M/WBE still cannot be confirmed or replaced, the proposed percentage of participation associated with the unverified M/WBE firm will <u>not be counted</u> and <u>will be deducted</u> from the overall proposed M/WBE goal.
- 7. <u>Any tier</u> of M/WBE subcontractors or suppliers that will be utilized in the contract work may count toward the MBE and WBE goal <u>as long as the tier subcontractors/suppliers are certified M/WBEs</u>. Work that an M/WBE subcontracts to a non-M/WBE firm does <u>not</u> count toward the M/WBE goal.
- 8. M/WBEs must perform a "commercially useful function" which is the provision of <u>real and actual work or products</u>, or performing a distinct element of work for which the business has the skills, qualifications and expertise, and the responsibility for the actual management and supervision of the work contracted.
- 9. Per the *Proposed Schedule of M/WBE Participation* "the undersigned (bidder/proposer) will enter into a formal agreement with the M/WBE Subcontractors/Proposers identified herein for work listed in this schedule, conditioned upon executing a contract with the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah." **This signed commitment is taken seriously by the City**, so do <u>not</u> list M/WBEs you do not plan to utilize. Any proposed changes must be pre-approved by the M/WBE Office, be based on legitimate business-related reasons, and still meet the M/WBE participation goals per the City's contract.
- 10. A bidder who is a certified M/WBE may count toward the goal the portion of work or services on a City contract that is actually performed by the M/WBE, including: the cost of supplies/materials purchased or equipment leased for contract work, fees for bona fide services such as professional or technical services, or for providing bonds or insurance specifically required for the performance of a City contract.
- 11. If awarded the contract, the MWBE Office will be reviewing your company's subcontracts, invoices and payment records to substantiate the completion of work and payment of M/WBEs. If the prime contractor is an M/WBE that is being included in its M/WBE goal, the prime contractor must maintain records that will be inspected to prove the portion of work performed, cost of work, and payments to the prime company.
- 12. Most bids for goods and materials do not have specific MWBE goals established for the contract. If no goals are include in the scope of work or General Specifications, you are not required to submit MWBE participation but encouraged to do so when the opportunity is available. The City maintains this information for statistical purposes only and it is not reflected in the award decision.
