

Resolution to extend the boundaries of the St. Patrick's Day Control Zone for March 13, 14 and 15, 2020

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah designated the 2020 Saint Patrick's Day Festival as March 13, 2020 at 6PM through March 15, 2020 at 6PM during the regular City Council meeting on December 19, 2019;

**AND WHEREAS**, the Control Zone is established to contain activities, limit items brought into the festival area and provide regulations and controls for patrons wishing to consume alcohol;

**AND WHEREAS**, the City wishes to extend the western boundary of the Control Zone to include the area established for motorcoach parking so as to prohibit items not allowed in the Control Zone from being taken off the motorcoaches by riders;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Control Zone area bounded by East Broad Street on the east, the Savannah River on the north, Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. to Bay lane to Fahm Street to River Street on the west, and Broughton Lane from Martin Luther King Boulevard to the east side of Drayton Street to Bay Lane to East Broad Street be designated as the Festival Control Zone, and that the City Manager is authorized to implement regulations and controls for the Festival Controlled Zone during the hours of March 13<sup>th</sup>, 6:00 p.m. through March 15<sup>th</sup>, 6:00 p.m. 2020.
