Zoning Review of Alcoholic Beverage License Request 22-005159-ABL

In reference to the application of **Brittany Nicole Oneal**, **T/A Cru Lounge**, requesting an alcoholic beverage license at **1639 E Victory Dr** (PIN 20077 17003) I have determined that the **Proposed Use**, *Restaurant* with *Retail consumption dealer (on-premises consumption of alcohol)* within the current Community Business (B-C) zoning district:

## I have determined that the Proposed Use(s):

- ☑ Is Permitted by Right: The principal use classification *Restaurant*, as defined in Article 13 of the zoning ordinance, is allowed by right in the zoning district. Accessory alcohol sales by the drink in association with a restaurant is permitted by right because the parcel is not within the boundaries of an Alcohol Density Overlay District.
- □ Is Not Permitted
- Requires a Special Use Permit from The Mayor and Aldermen:
- □ Is Permitted as a Limited Use with Standards
- □ Is Permitted as a Nonconforming Use

Additionally, I have determined that the Proposed Use:


- □ Is an Existing use/occupancy, but new ownership, management or request.

Further, I have determined that **Parking** at the property:

- The applicant has gone through Site Plan Review process, and the project meets the requirements for the 32 vehicle parking spaces as required for the principal use classification of a restaurant.
- The proposed use(s) are deficient in the parking standards

Additionally, I have determined that the Location has:

- Zoning Ordinance violations that need to be corrected prior to the issuance of the Alcoholic Beverage License
- Has Business Location Approval application submitted February 10, 2022, currently on hold pending ABL approval per File No. 22-000641-BA.
