RE: Utility Service to Hutchinson Island, Savannah, Georgia

Dear Mr. Bolden:

As you may be aware, Atlanta Gas Light Company (AGL) has been recently engaged to extend natural gas service across the Savannah River to Hutchinson Island. Comcast of Georgia/South Carolina, Inc (Comcast) also plans to extend its facilities to Hutchinson Island in conjunction with the gas line extension.

AGL's and Comcast's facilities propose to utilize the eastern portion of the existing utility crossing easement under the Savannah River adjacent to the Marriot Hotel property (middle crossing) to gain access to Hutchinson Island, as depicted on the attached preliminary plat. The proposed facilities are comprised of AGL's eight inch gas main and Comcast's four inch conduit.

It is our understanding that the State Properties Commission (SPC) granted easement rights to Chatham County and the City of Savannah under portions of the Savannah River in 1998 to accommodate the extension of utilities to Hutchinson Island. The County and the City passed resolutions in late 1998 authorizing AGL to utilize a portion of the river crossing easement. Unfortunately, AGL did not exercise this authorization in 1998, but wishes to do so now.

Our engineering consultant, Mr. Curt Askeland with Hussey, Gay, Bell & DeYoung (HGBD) (912) 354-4626), or our acquisition consultant, Mr. Billy Gordon with Moreland Altobelli Associates, Inc. (MAAI (912) 963-1112), can address any questions or concerns you or your staff may have.

At your very earliest convenience, please advise of SPC's concurrence with the prior authorizations for the use of the existing utility crossing easement.
