




Hotel/mo	tel, 16-74 rooms; within the current D-CBD Zoning District:
⊠	Is Permitted by Right: The principal use classification, Hotel/motel, 16-74 rooms is allowed by right in the zoning district and is defined as follows in Article 13 of the zoning ordinance:
	Hotel, Motel: A lodging establishment for transient guests with more than 15 guest rooms. Any on-premises use that is accessible by the general public, such as a restaurant, bar or event/assembly space, is a separate principal use and must be an allowed use in the base zoning district. Any on-premises use that is accessible only by hotel guests is an accessory use.
	The accessory use Retail consumption dealer (on premise consumption of alcohol) shall be limited and accessible to hotel guests.
