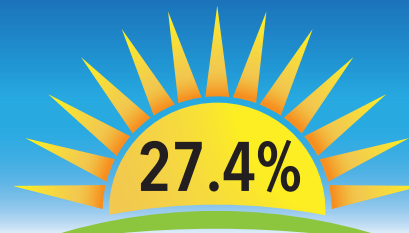


Cities are growing at a faster rate than the state's overall population:



Daytime Population

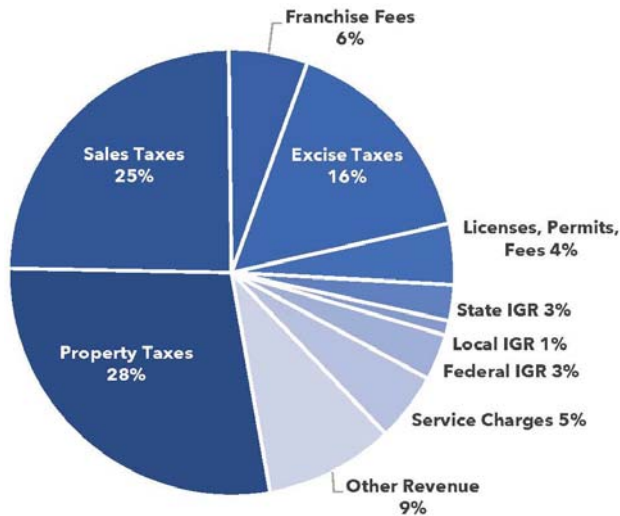

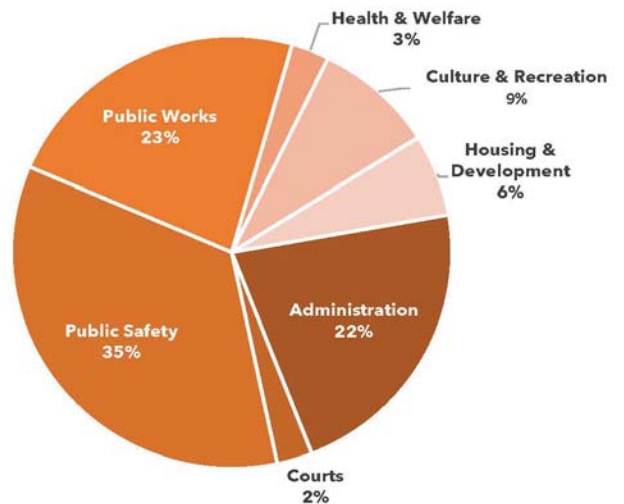

SPLOST AND TSPLOST REVENUES

94% of SPLOST referenda have been approved by local voters since 2001.

\$6.6 billion in SPLOST revenues were distributed to local governments to pay for voter-approved capital projects between 2015 and 2019.

27 Georgia counties have Single County TSPLOST in place, **AND 4** regions have implemented a Regional (TIA) TSPLOST. (as of December 2019)

91 counties are either in a Single County TSPLOST or TIA Region. (as of December 2019)

Local funds will not be enough – a long-term, strong local-state-federal partnership is needed to address our state's infrastructure needs.
