SPECIFICATIONS AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS

4.0 The purpose of these specifications is to describe the requirements for fertilizer, insecticide, herbicide, grass seed and other miscellaneous horticultural products for use by the City of Savannah Greenscapes Division and Parks and Recreation Department.

To submit pricing electronically for this event, enter pricing for each line item shown under the lines tab on the event summary. To enter pricing manually, complete the attached bid proposal form. Manually submitted bids must be submitted on the bid proposal forms contained in these specifications in order to be considered.

A pre-bid conference has been scheduled to be conducted at the Purchasing Office, Second Floor, 1375 Chatham Parkway, Savannah, Georgia 31405. This meeting will allow contractors to discuss the specifications and resolve any questions and/or misunderstandings that may arise with City staff. You are invited to attend.

- 4.1 Fertilizer, Insecticide, and Herbicide
 - 4.1.1 The chemicals acquired in these products shall be suitable for use on newly sprigged or established laws of St. Augustine, Zoysia, Centipede, Bermuda Grass, and Rye Grasses.
 - 4.1.2 The fertilizer acquired shall be a slow release, dust-free, ready-to use granular product that is uniform in size and formulated to produce shoot growth and root development.
 - 4.1.3 The fertilizer in this product shall be an easy-spreading, non-burning, long-lasting maintenance fertilizer.
 - 4.1.4 All fertilizer products will be of standard particle size with an SGN Rating of 240 or less unless specified otherwise.
 - 4.1.5 Products shall be specially formulated for high-traffic turfgrass areas such as public parks, schools, and athletic fields
 - 4.1.6 Clumping and/or trash found in product will be grounds for canceling contract.

4.2 Grass Seed

- 4.2.1 Types of seed: See Attachment A. Acceptable varieties: Three Way Blend Professional Grade, or approved equal.
- 4.2.2 Seed must be certified seed with a germination rate that is a minimum of 90%.

- 4.3 This is an annual contract and prices shall remain firm. This agreement may be renewed for up to three (3) additional twelve (12) month periods, if all contracting parties so agree and services provided by the vendor have been satisfactory. The first term of this contract shall begin upon award and shall end on December 31, 2019. All remaining renewal options, if exercised, shall begin on January 1 and end on December 31 of each subsequent year.
- 5.0 General Conditions
- 5.1 The bid response must include the following documents in this order:

 - Proposed Schedule of DBE Participation
 - Other submittals as stated

Instruction for Completing Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlement (SAVE) Form
