

**HURRICANE MATTHEW SPECIAL REVENUE FUND SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET  
APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE**

**AN ORDINANCE TO RECOGNIZE AND APPROPRIATE FUNDING SOURCES RELATED TO THE CITY'S HURRICANE MATTHEW SPECIAL REVENUE FUND RECEIVED FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY AND OTHER SOURCES USED TO FUND THE CITY'S CLEANUP AND RECOVERY EFFORTS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Savannah was greatly affected by the destructive powers of Hurricane Matthew in October of 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, a Presidential disaster declaration made available to the City of Savannah federal grants through the Federal Emergency Management Agency for cleanup and recovery in the aftermath of the storm; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Savannah has expended federal disaster grants and other matching funds to restore and repair damaged aspects of its operations and property; and

**WHEREAS**, O.C.G.A. 36-81-3 requires the adoption of a resolution or ordinance in order to approve a supplemental budget appropriation to the City's fiscal year 2017 budget;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah that the following amendment to the fiscal year 2017 budget be made:

**Section 1.** The following revenues and appropriations are amended for the Hurricane Matthew Special Revenue Fund for the year 2017 (January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017):
