The Industrial and Domestic Water Department uses approximately 1,100 tons of hydrated lime per year. The lime is used for finished water pH control and in the treatment of alkalinity control. Specific pH criteria are given by the Georgia Environmental Protection Division for drinking water. A proper alkalinity is required to adequately treat raw water into finished water.
