AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND PART 8, CHAPTER 3, ZONING, TO AMEND ARTICLE A (DEFINITIONS) AND TO REPEAL ALL OTHER ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

<u>BE IT ORDAINED</u> by the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah, Georgia, in regular meeting of Council assembled and pursuant to lawful authority thereof:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> That Part 8, Chapter 3, Zoning of the Code of the City of Savannah, Georgia (2003) hereinafter referenced as "Code," be amended as follows:

Sec. 8-3002. Definitions

Inn. A lodging establishment for transient guests with no more than 15 guest rooms. <u>Must be owner-occupied or provide 24-hour / 7 day a week onsite staff.</u> Any on-premises use that is accessible by the general public, such as a restaurant, bar or event/assembly space, is a separate principal use and must be an allowed use in the base zoning district. Any on-premises use that is accessible only by hotel guests is an accessory use.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: That the requirement of Section 8-3182(f) of said Code and the law in such cases made and provided has been satisfied. That an opportunity for a public hearing was afforded anyone having an interest or property right which may have been affected by this zoning amendment, said notice being published in the *Savannah Morning News* on the ______ day of ______, 2018, a copy of said notice being attached hereto and made a part hereof.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: Upon the effective date of the ordinance all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
