- 5. Colleges within the Historic District or the Victorian District (Savannah River to 37th Street, East Broad Street to MLK Boulevard) when the premises are zoned to allow such use in Historic/Victorian District? NO

For businesses classified as banquet, reception halls, or event venues whose dominant business activity and related gross sales are from the rental of facilities and catering of food for banquets, receptions, and events, there shall be no distance requirements for businesses within the Historic District when the premises are zoned to allow such use and such businesses are otherwise determined eligible for a beverage alcohol license for consumption on premises.
- 7. (v) No distance requirement shall apply to colleges within the Historic or Victorian Districts when the premises are zoned to allow such use; (vi) For businesses classified as banquet, reception halls, or event venues whose dominant business activity and related gross sales receipts are from the rental of facilities and catering of food for banquets, receptions, and events, there shall be no distance requirements for businesses within the Historic District when the premises are zoned to allow such use and such businesses are otherwise determined eligible for a beverage alcohol license for consumption on premises and off premises.
