MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING CONCERNING MODIFIED EXTENSION OF FACILITIES USE AGREEMENT

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU") is made and entered on the date of full execution by the undersigned parties between the Mayor and Alderman of the City of Savannah (the "City") and the Savannah-Chatham County Board of Public Education (the "District"); are each a "Party," and may be collectively referred to as the "Parties."

WHEREAS, in 2017 the parties entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement for the use of specified District facilites at Windsor Forest Elementary School, White Bluff Elementary School, and Windsor Forest High School.

The Agreement is attached as "Exhibit A" to this MOU. The Agreement is will expire by its own terms on May 30, 2022.

WHEREAS, the parties agree to extend the Agreement to May 31, 2023.

WHEREAS, the parties further agree to exclude the use of certain Disrtict facilites (athletic fields) at White Bluff Elementary School and Windsor Forest High School from the scope of the Agreement as extended and amended by this MOU.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises, conditions, representations, and agreements set forth herein, the Parties hereto MUTUALLY AGREE that the terms of the attached Agreement, as amended in scope of use as described above, will extend to a new termination date of May 31, 2023.

The athletic fields at White Bluff Elementary School and Windsor Forest High School are excluded from the scope of the Agreement as amended by this MOU. SCCPSS athletic fields are addressed within the scope another shared use Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Savannah.

This MOU is an agreement between government entities in Georgia for the provision of services and the use of facilities for activities, services and facilities which the undersigned parties are authorized to provide. Ga. Const. Art. IX, § III, ¶ I(a).
