SPECIFICATIONS AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS

4.0 The purpose of these specifications is to describe requirements for liquid chlorine in one-ton cylinders for use by the City of Savannah's Industrial and Domestic (I&D) Water Treatment Plant and Water Reclamation Plant.

Manually submitted bids must be submitted on the bid proposal forms contained in these specifications in order to be considered. Bids may be submitted manually to the address listed in the bid documents insufficient time to ensure receipt by the Purchasing Department on or before 1:30 P.M. on the date specified in the web page listing for this event. **Electronic responses will be accepted for this event.**

- 4.1 AWWA Specifications: Liquid Chlorine must meet all applicable specifications of the American Water Works Association (AWWA B301-18 & Current NSF specs).
- 4.2 In general, one-ton cylinders will be used at the President Street Wastewater Treatment Facility located at 1400 East President Street, Savannah, Georgia 31402 and the Industrial and Domestic (I&D) Potable Water Treatment Facility located at 6183 Highway 21 North, Port Wentworth, Georgia 31407.
- 4.3 The successful bidder shall furnish all of the liquid chlorine requirements as may be required during the annual contract period. The City reserves the right to increase or decrease quantities and/or locations as required.
- 4.4 This contract will allow for price changes on a semi-annual basis. Specifically, a review will be conducted jointly by the City and the successful vendor to determine the current market trend for chlorine. Based on this review, the price paid will be adjusted up or down. If an agreement cannot be reached, the City reserves the right to award the contract to the next lowest bidder or to re-bid the contract.
- 4.5 No fuel surcharges are to be invoiced unless prior approval is made by the City of Savannah.
- 4.6 The successful bidder shall offer Chlorine Institute approved safety training bi-annually. One session shall be held at the I&D facility and one shall be held at the President Street facility.
- 4.7 The City of Savannah reserves the right to request for a cylinder to be removed from City property if it is deemed to be unsafe. The vendor shall provide support for an onsite response as soon as possible if an emergency occurs. The damaged cylinder shall be removed within 48 hours.
- 4.8 This is an annual contract. Prices shall remain firm. This agreement may be renewed for up to three (3) additional twelve (12) month periods if all contracting parties so agree and services provided by the vendor have been satisfactory.
- 5.0 General Conditions
- 5.1 The bid response must include the following documents in this order:

 - Exception Sheet
 - Non-Discrimination Statement
 - Proposed Schedule of DBE Participation

Instruction for Completing Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlement (SAVE) Form

O.C.G.A. § 50-36-1, requires Georgia's cities to comply with the federal **Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Program**. SAVE is a federal program used to verify that applicants for certain "public benefits" are legally present in the United States. Contracts with the City are considered "public benefits." Therefore, the successful bidder will be required to provide the Affidavit Verifying Status for City of Savannah Benefit Application prior to receiving any City contract. The affidavit is included as part of this bid package but is only required of the successful bidder.
