SPECIFICATIONS AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS

4.0 The purpose of these specifications is to describe requirements for one one-ton dump truck for use by the City of Savannah.

To submit pricing electronically for this event, enter pricing for each line item shown under the lines tab on the event summary. To enter pricing manually, complete the attached bid proposal form. Manually submitted bids must be submitted on the bid proposal forms contained in these specifications in order to be considered.

- 4.1 Chassis
 - 4.1.1 Chassis: One ton with dual rear wheels, minimum 10,000 pounds gross vehicle weight.
 - 4.1.2 Engine: Gasoline powered V8 with heavy duty cooling system (minimum 6.2 liter).
 - 4.1.3 Electrical: 130 amp alternator, 750CCA battery.
 - 4.1.4 Transmission: Six speed automatic.
 - 4.1.5 Cab: Regular cab with bench seat, vinyl upholstery, painted white.
 - 4.1.6 Power steering and brakes.
 - 4.1.7 Heavy duty suspension.
 - 4.1.8 Cab to axle clearance sufficient to provide mounting of requested body and/or toolbox.
 - 4.1.9 Tires: Manufacturer's standard for gross vehicle weight, including full size spare wheel and tire.
 - 4.1.10 Fuel tank: Thirty (30) gallon minimum.
 - 4.1.11 AM/FM radio, factory installed.
 - 4.1.12 Air conditioning, factory installed.
 - 4.1.13 Towing package
 - Class 4 towing hitch with combination two inch ball/pintle hitch.
 - Seven blade trailer connector and four pin connector.
 - Eyes for safety chains.
 - Hitches shall be receiver type.

- Towing mirrors Either west coast or pull out type. Vendor must ensure mirrors give full view past the body.
- All units shall have electric brake controller wired into trailer connector.
- 4.1.14 Unit shall be equipped with a back-up alarm.
- 4.1.15 Dump unit strobe to be mounted on headboard of body, wired to a switch inside cab. Switch powered only with ignition on.
- 4.1.16 Unit shall be equipped with cab steps.
- 4.1.17 Cab color: White.
- 4.1.18 Keys: Four sets of keys.
- 4.1.19 Vehicle must be delivered with a half of tank of fuel minimum.
- 4.2 Dump body with two toolbox mounted under dump body one on each side approximately five feet long and 18 inches deep.
 - 4.2.1 Dimensions
 - Length: 12 feet
 - Width: Eight feet
 - Side height: 36 inches
 - 4.2.2 12 gauge permanent steel sides to be constructed with hinged swing open doors centered on each side with positive type latches to secure when open or closed, constructed to make opening and closing by one person with minimal effort.
 - Three inch channel side supports
 - Front head height: 36 inches
 - Three inch structural channel up posts and framing
 - 10 gauge sheet
 - 4.2.3 Longsills: Five inch 6.7# structural channel.
 - 4.2.4 Cross sills: Three inch 4.1# structural channel on 16 inch centers.
 - 4.2.5 Floor: 10 gauge smooth steel.
 - 4.2.6 Tailgate to be 12 gauge steel swing open type doors with positive type latches to secure when opened or closed.
 - 4.2.7 Hoist: NTEA class 20 with safety prop and electro hydraulic power unit.
 - 4.2.8 Pull out self-retracting tarp system. No exceptions.
 - 4.2.9 E-Z step or equal mounted right side by side door with grab handle mounted inside body.

- 4.2.10 D.O.T. approved lighting system with recessed marker lights (all body lights to be LED). Two each Whelan Ion series WIONSMF (amber/white) surface mount light mounted in front and two (2) WIONSMA amber mounted rear. Rear lights should be mounted below bed surface.
- 4.2.11 Paint: Gloss black acrylic enamel.
- 4.2.12 Bottom 12 inches of inside of dump body to be covered with a spray in liner, line-x or equal.
- 4.3 Vendor shall supply a wireless fuel system for each vehicle. The system is from MECO Atlanta (770.448.6933) or MECO Savannah (912.233.4523) Each vehicle will require a Micro Data Pass PLUS, CAN (black) item #M09693B009and a, Fuel Cube- antennae and security chip all-in-one Item #M09680B021. Vendor shall provide the cost of the parts in the price of the vehicle excluding the cost of installation. The City of Savannah will be responsible for the installation of the parts.
- 4.4 All vehicles and vehicular equipment delivered to the City must be accompanied by two (2) copies of complete parts, shop repair, and operator's manuals. Actual hard copies of the manuals or a CD version are acceptable. The parts manuals must show all component parts including, but not limited to, component assemblies and their substitute components identified by manufactures part number. Any component or sub-assembly not manufactured by the O.E.M. must be identified including the name of the manufacturer of said component and said manufacturer's part numbers and nomenclature. All parts information must be specific to the unit delivered to the City. All shop repair manuals will include, but not be limited to the following. Complete disassembly instructions, adjustment and replacement procedures, wiring diagrams, hydraulic schematics (where applicable), hose routing, location and function of sensors, time standards where available, and trouble-shooting guide.
- 4.5 All vehicles must be accompanied by a factory recommended preventive maintenance schedule including procedures, time hour's mileage intervals, replacement part numbers, and fluid specifications.
- 4.6 The City reserves the right to order additional units outside of the number specified herein during calendar years 2019 and 2020. If the vendor does not desire to provide the unit at the original bid price, the vendor is under no obligation to do so.
- 4.7 Previous model year vehicle (new, never titled) are acceptable, if available
- 4.8 The successful bidder shall be responsible for applying for all Georgia tags and titles. Associated costs must be considered in the bid price.
- 4.9 No dealer advertising is to be on a vehicle.
- 4.10 Bids will be accepted from vehicle dealerships only. No bids from vehicle brokers will be considered.
- 4.11 Delivery
 - 4.11.1 All prices bid must be FOB Savannah location with all delivery and handling charges included.
 - 4.11.2 Bidders shall include estimated delivery time.

4.11.3 The successful bidder will be responsible for delivering the vehicles to [City of Savannah Vehicle Maintenance Department 6900 Sallie Mood Drive Savannah, Georgia 31406

5.0 General Conditions

5.1 The bid response shall include all documents required in the bidder's checklist.

All referenced documents must be completed and returned in their entirety to constitute a complete bid.

Instruction for Completing Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlement (SAVE) Form

O.C.G.A. § 50-36-1, requires Georgia's cities to comply with the federal **Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Program**. SAVE is a federal program used to verify that applicants for certain "public benefits" are legally present in the United States. Contracts with the City are considered "public benefits." Therefore, the successful bidder will be required to provide the Affidavit Verifying Status for City of Savannah Benefit Application prior to receiving any City contract. The affidavit is included as part of this bid package but is only required of the successful bidder.
