The stature of limitation for filing a claim under the Laws of the State of Georgia in some injury or damage cases, such as damages caused by defects in streets and sidewalks and the sewer system, is not liable unless it in such cases, the City is not liable and such petitions may be denied. You, nevertheless, defect. In most cases, the City has no notice of defects until the initial injury occurs and first had knowledge of the defect causing the injury and thereafter failed to correct the Notice: "Be advised that the City of Savannah, as a Municipal Corporation, Chartered against the City is six (6) months.
