

Notice: "Be advised that the City of Savannah, as a Municipal Corporation, Chartered under the Laws of the State of Georgia in some injury or damage cases, such as damages caused by defects in streets and sidewalks and the sewer system, is not liable unless it first had knowledge of the defect causing the injury and thereafter failed to correct the defect. In most cases, the City has no notice of defects until the initial injury occurs and in such cases, the City is not liable and such petitions may be denied. You, nevertheless, have the right as a citizen to present your petition and have it investigated and resolved and/or heard by the Mayor and Aldermen." The statute of limitation for filing a claim against the City is six (6) months.

Dear Mayor and Alderman:

I am writing on behalf of Jane and Ed Feiler who live at 330 Lee Boulevard in the Habersham Woods area of Savannah. The Feilers would like to obtain title to the western ½ of the unopened section of Pickett Street (formerly Reynolds street) adjacent to the east side of their lot. A plat by Coleman Company, Inc. showing the area is attached.

It is not unusual for portion of streets and/or lanes in Habersham Woods to be abandoned by the City and Quitclaimed to the adjoining property owners. For example, I have attached a Sagis Map showing that the Feiler's neighbor facing McLaws Street has already obtained title to the western portion of Pickett Street adjacent to their home.

This letter serves as a formal request on behalf of Jane A. Feiler for abandonment of the property shown on the attached plat to be followed by the Quitclaim by the City to Mrs. Feiler for an amount to be determined pursuant to City policy.

If any additional information is needed please let me know.

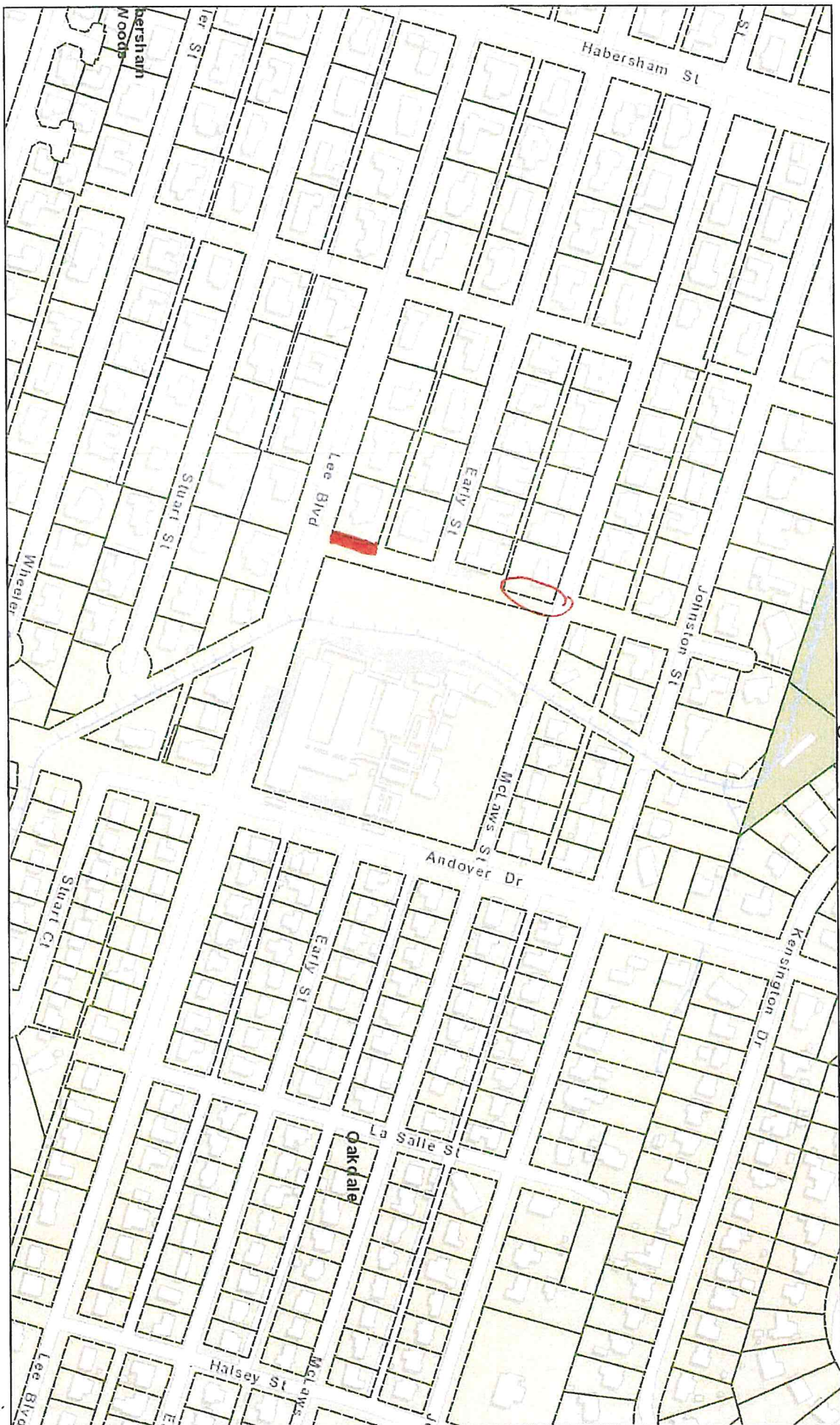

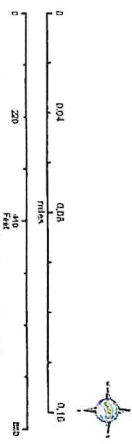
