### NOTES

Notification of the emergency procurement of all-hazards vessel engine replacement from Donnelly Yachts in the amount of \$186,729.16. The Fire Department used the services to replace two engines that were damaged making them inoperable. The vessel and crew was put out of service in late 2018 and the vessel was recently put back in-service, funding was secured for maintenance and repair however the personnel positions were not reinstated. For proper operation, care and maintenance, a dedicated marine unit is needed. Once funding and support were re-established, the Fire Department began operating and maintaining the vessel. During the renewed operating status, some mechanical issues were discovered that were in-part caused by an extended period of down time. Scale and blockages were allowed to form in the heat exchangers, water coolers and fuel coolers which led to restricted cooling capacity of the engines. The reduced cooling of the engines in turn led to mechanical failures such as cracks in the head, scored cylinders and exhaust issues, and failure of the fuel and heat exchangers.
