### NOTES

Recommend approval to procure two by-pass pumps for lift stations located at the Eastern Wharf Development from Thompson Pump and Manufacturing Company, Inc. in the amount of \$112,533. Public Works and Water Resources will use the by-pass pumps to provide sanitary sewer service and station operations. The pumps are vital for the lift stations which will serve the new development east of the Marriott Hotel on General McIntosh Boulevard and north of East President Street.

The City will use a cooperative purchasing agreement with Sourcewell (formally National Joint Powers Alliance). Through this cooperative, the contract was competitively bid and awarded to Thompson Pump and Manufacturing Company, Inc. It included a one year term with multiple renewal options and expires on March 14, 2022
