

#### RECTANGULAR CLARIFIER

#### **EVENT NO. 5492**

#### SPECIFICATIONS AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS

4.0 The purpose of these specifications is to describe the requirements for parts needed for non-metallic rectangular clarifier.

To submit pricing electronically for this event, enter pricing for each line item shown under the lines tab on the event summary. To enter pricing manually, complete the attached bid proposal form. Manually submitted bids must be submitted on the bid proposal forms contained in these specifications in order to be considered.

A pre-bid conference has been scheduled to be conducted at the Purchasing Office, City Hall, third floor, 2 East Bay Street, Savannah, Georgia 31401. This meeting will allow contractors to discuss the specifications and resolve any questions and/or misunderstandings that may arise with City staff. You are invited to attend.

#### 4.1 Specification

The collector chain shall be non-metallic NCS-720-S, having six inch (6") pitch links with a minimum weight of 1.3 pounds per foot. The chain shall have a published working load of not less than 3100 pounds based on strength, fatigue, and wear considerations. Chain links shall be manufactured from thermoplastic polyester resin. The links shall be integrally molded with the barrel and both side bars formed in one piece to assure squareness and strength of the link.

Connecting pins shall be non-metallic, molded in one piece, from acetyl resin. Pins shall have molded T-head which shall seat and lock inside molded chain link to prevent pin rotation. The pins shall positively lock when chain is assembled.

Rigid, non-metallic attachment link shall be furnished, manufactured from the same materials as the chain link. The attachment links shall extend the full depth of the flight and be integrally molded in one (1) piece to assure flight alignment. The attachment link bolt pattern shall conform to industry standards and shall accommodate four (4) 3/8 inch diameter, 316 stainless steel flight bolts.

The drive chains shall be non-metallic NH-78 manufactured of a reinforced nylon resin with stainless steel pins. Chain shall consist of 2.609 inch pitch links and shall have a minimum working load of 1740 pounds.

The fiberglass scraper flights shall be three feet (3') by eight feet (8') by 16 feet, seven inches (7"), ten (10) hole on the long flights, and three feet (3') by eight feet (8') by three feet, nine inches (3'9"), eight (8) hole on the short flights nominal size specifically designed for sludge collector service. The scraper flights shall be pultruded channel shape having continuous fiberglass filaments in addition to a fiberglass mat running the full length of the member and shall include a scraper lip on the leading edge to insure cleaning of the tank floor. Buoyant flight design will not be acceptable. Angle or L

shape flight will not be acceptable. All flights shall be drilled and notched and include all necessary attachment hardware of 316 stainless steel.

The filler blocks for bolting to the chain attachment links shall be furnished and manufactured from the same materials as the chain link.

All wear shoes shall be reversible providing two usable wearing surfaces and be nominal one-half inch (1/2") thick cast nylon-6 material. Carrying wear shoes shall run on floor rails. Return wear shoes shall run on angle tracks and be lugged (for flight alignment).

Wear Strips to be ultra-high molecular weight polyethylene (UHMW-PE) measuring approximately 2-5/8 inches wide and 3/8 inch thick and supplied in ten foot (10') lengths with one (1) round and three (3) slotted holes to allow for thermal expansion and include all necessary attachment hardware needed for installation and allow for thermal expansion. All hardware shall be 316 stainless steel.

Drive Chain Tension Adjustment "Take Up" Assembly. Assembly shall be 100% Cast Nylon-6 and Designed to provide adequate adjustment of drive chain tension. Tensioner 20.50"x3.75"x1.50", 14.50" Travel (2.50/3.00 Centers) One 1.24" hole for Sprocket shaft, One 5.50"x1.25"Shaft will be supplied the shaft needs to have holes drilled for Slotted Spring Pins to hold shaft and sprocket.

Idler Take up Sprocket. Shell be 100% Cast Nylon-6 solid construction NH-78 7 Tooth Sprocket, Glass Filled Nylon 6/6-20% GR, Plain Bore, 1.275" Bore DIA, 1.500" Length Thru Bore, Root DIA 5.113" Outside DIA 6.598", Tooth Width 0.938. All hardware shall be 316 Stainless steel.

The Jaw Clutch "Driving Sprocket" Assembly with 11 tooth Sprocket NH78 shall be provided with Keyway, Shear Pin and Trip Pin Function. The Shear Pin to Break at 1665 Lbf On the Drive Chain. All hardware provided in 316 Stainless Steel.

Idler Sprocket NCS-720S Chain Saver 17 Tooth Cast Nylon 6, Plain Bore. Tooth Pitch 6.000", Chain Saver Rim DIA 13.920", Pitch DIA 16.609", Outside DIA 17.088", Shaft DIA 5.280" Bore DIA 5.340".

Chain Saver Sprocket NCS-720S 23 Tooth Assembly, Cast Nylon 6, Split With Set Screws, Keyway, Tooth Pitch 6.000", Chain Saver Rim DIA 19.840", Pitch DIA 22.239", Outside DIA 22.950", Shaft DIA 5.775", Bore DIA 5.775", Keyway 1.500"x0.900".

Head shaft Assembly. The longitudinal and cross collector drive shafts will be manufacture from high strength glass fiber reinforced polyester resin using telescoping tubes for ease of shaft assembly to non-metallic wall mounted stub shaft spindles. The inside diameter of all drive shaft assemblies will have a tubular UHMW bearing and replaceable sleeve of cast Nylon-6 material.

After tubular assembly is expanded and fitted to the stub shaft spindle assembly, they shal be held in place with non-metallic hardware as required. Drive shaft to have keyways and keys sized to fit the non-metallic sprockets.

Tubular stub shaft bearing to be solid type construction, UHMW-PE. Outside diameter of stub shaft bearing will slide fit to inside diameter of non-metallic telescope drive shaft assembly.

Driven Bull Sprocket. Shall be split construction to facilitate installation. Sprocket shall be provided with keyway and set screws for attachment to head shaft. Sprocket shall be 100% Cast Nylon-6. Offset type.

Band Barrel Wrap 301 Stainless Steel NCS7. All Hardware to be Stainless Steel.

## **Developing a Strong M/WBE Participation Plan**

Key facts every bidder/proposer needs to know prior to developing their M/WBE Participation Plan:

- All bidders/proposers must submit a "Proposed Schedule of M/WBE Participation" which identifies the minority and/or woman-owned companies that have agreed to participate in the project if awarded. All companies listed on the form must be certified as either minority-owned and controlled or woman-owned and controlled. The City does not accept a company's "self-identification" as minority or woman-owned.
- 2. <u>Proof</u> of M/WBE certification from the certifying agency is <u>required to accompany the bid</u>; and certification must have been completed by the City of Savannah, a federally-recognized or a state-level certifying agency (USDOT, State DOT, SBA 8(a) or GMSDC) <u>utilizing certification standards comparable to</u> the City of Savannah.
- 3. The certification must have been approved <u>prior</u> to the due date of this bid. A firm that has submitted an application for certification but has <u>not</u> been certified will not be counted toward the M/WBE goal.
- 4. The M/WBE Office <u>will be contacting all M/WBE firms</u> included in the bidder's M/WBE Plan to confirm each: a) was contacted by the bidder/proposer; b) performs the type of work listed; and c) agreed to participate.
- 5. To expedite the verification process, bidders/proposers need to: provide accurate phone numbers for all M/WBEs listed; ensure M/WBEs know to expect to be contacted by phone and email; request M/WBEs be accessible during the critical period before bid-opening; and advise M/WBEs that City staff <u>must</u> receive the M/WBE's confirmation that the firm agreed to participate in the bid/proposal in order for the prime contractor to receive credit toward their proposed M/WBE participation goals.
- 6. If a proposed M/WBE cannot be confirmed as certified, performing the type of work described <u>or</u> agreeing to participate, the bidder/proposer will be notified and given a pre-determined period to submit a correction. If an M/WBE still cannot be confirmed or replaced, the proposed percentage of participation associated with the unverified M/WBE firm will <u>not be counted</u> and <u>will be deducted</u> from the overall proposed M/WBE goal.
- 7. <u>Any tier</u> of M/WBE subcontractors or suppliers that will be utilized in the contract work may count toward the MBE and WBE goal <u>as long as the tier subcontractors/suppliers are certified M/WBEs</u>. Work that an M/WBE subcontracts to a non-M/WBE firm does <u>not</u> count toward the M/WBE goal.
- 8. M/WBEs must perform a "commercially useful function" which is the provision of <u>real and actual work or products</u>, or performing a distinct element of work for which the business has the skills, qualifications and expertise, and the responsibility for the actual management and supervision of the work contracted.
- 9. Per the *Proposed Schedule of M/WBE Participation* "the undersigned (bidder/proposer) will enter into a formal agreement with the M/WBE Subcontractors/Proposers identified herein for work listed in this schedule, conditioned upon executing a contract with the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah." **This signed commitment is taken seriously by the City**, so do not list M/WBEs you do not plan to utilize. Any proposed changes must be pre-approved by the M/WBE Office, be based on legitimate business-related reasons, and still meet the M/WBE participation goals per the City's contract.
- 10. A bidder who is a certified M/WBE may count toward the goal the portion of work or services on a City contract that is actually performed by the M/WBE, including: the cost of supplies/materials purchased or equipment leased for contract work, fees for bona fide services such as professional or technical services, or for providing bonds or insurance specifically required for the performance of a City contract.
- 11. If awarded the contract, the MWBE Office <u>will be reviewing your company's subcontracts, invoices and payment records</u> to substantiate the completion of work and payment of M/WBEs. If the prime contractor is an M/WBE that is being included in its M/WBE goal, the prime contractor must maintain records <u>that will be inspected</u> to prove the portion of work performed, cost of work, and payments to the prime company.
- 12. Most bids for goods and materials do not have specific MWBE goals established for the contract. If no goals are include in the scope of work or General Specifications, you are not required to submit MWBE participation but encouraged to do so when the opportunity is available. The City maintains this information for statistical purposes only and it is not reflected in the award decision.

# Instruction for Completing Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlement (SAVE) Form

O.C.G.A. § 50-36-1, requires Georgia's cities to comply with the federal **Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Program**. SAVE is a federal program used to verify that applicants for certain "public benefits" are legally present in the United States. Contracts with the City are considered "public benefits." Therefore, the successful bidder will be required to provide the Affidavit Verifying Status for City of Savannah Benefit Application prior to receiving any City contract. The affidavit is included as part of this bid package but is only required of the successful bidder.
