

KITCHEN RENOVATION AND FLOORING REPLACEMENT FOR SAVANNAH FIRE STATION 7

SPECIFICATIONS AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS

4.0 The purpose of these specifications is to describe requirements for the kitchen renovation and flooring replacement at Savannah Fire Station 7 as shown in Attachment 1, Design Scheme Proposal. The fire station is located at 6902 Sallie Mood Drive, Savannah, Georgia 31406.

This event is only open to Savannah Business Enterprise (SBE) certified firms. Responses received from non-SBE certified firms will not be opened or read aloud. For more information about the Savannah Business Enterprise program, please visit the City's Office of Business Opportunity's webpage (http://savannahga.gov/483/Office-of-Business-Opportunity).

To enter pricing manually, complete the attached bid proposal form. Manually submitted bids must be submitted on the bid proposal forms contained in these specifications in order to be considered. No electronic responses will be accepted for this event.

A pre-bid conference has been scheduled to be conducted at the Purchasing Office, 1375 Chatham Parkway, 2nd floor, Savannah, Georgia 31405. This meeting will allow contractors to discuss the specifications and resolve any questions and/or misunderstandings that may arise with City staff. You are invited to attend.

4.1 Kitchen Renovation

The scope of work shall include all materials, installation, and labor for this renovation as shown in Attachment 2. The kitchen renovation shall include painting, subway tile backsplash, palm wood upper cabinets, wooden lockers with locks, stainless steel counter tops with sink and fixtures, stainless steel lower cabinetry and shelving, and stainless steel refrigerator and microwave. The contractor shall install a towel dispenser and soap dispenser that will be provided. The contractor shall replace all stained or damaged ceiling tiles from existing grid. The kitchen shall be fully functional and work area cleaned upon completion. Any required permitting shall be the responsibility of the contractor. Additionally, the renovation shall include the removal and disposal of existing cabinetry, counter tops, sink, and refrigerator. The existing range and hood will remain and shall not be moved.

- 4.1.1 The contractor shall furnish paint, tile, trim and millwork, and cabinetry as specified in Attachment 3.
- 4.1.2 Suggested plumbing fixtures and appliances are shown in Attachment 4. The contractor may substitute equivalent items. The City reserves the right to determine adequacy of substitutes. The refrigerator shall have a bottom freezer and the microwave shall be installed above the counter top as shown in Attachment 1.

4.2 Flooring Replacement

The required flooring product and colors are specified in Attachment 3. The flooring design is shown in Attachment 5. The flooring replacement shall include the removal and disposal of the existing floor covering if necessary and the materials, labor, and installation of the new flooring and base.

4.3 License Requirements

- 4.3.1 The proposer shall have all requisite licensing and certificates required by federal, state, and local regulations to complete the scope of work.
- 4.3.2 The proposer shall have specialized training required by manufacturers to install the specified materials in order to satisfy the warranty protections.

SECTION 01310 DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS EMPLOYMENT PROVISIONS

The City of Savannah actively encourages employment and participation of small and disadvantaged businesses in all City contracts. Attention of the bidders is called to contract conditions contained herein pertaining to non-discrimination, equal employment opportunity, subcontracts, and opportunities for project area residents.

It is the policy of the City of Savannah that disadvantaged business enterprises (DBEs) be given fair opportunity to participate in the performance of services for the City, and that prime contractors utilize DBE subcontractors and suppliers to the fullest extent possible consistent with the efficient performance of the contract. The City of Savannah has not established a DBE goal for this project.

No bidder shall enter into an agreement with any DBE that would in any way limit the DBE's opportunities to sell to, or act as subcontractor for, any other party. Violation of this requirement would be grounds to deem the bidder non-responsive to this bid solicitation.

Any proposed changes must meet established DBE goals and conform to contract regulations and DBE Program Requirements.
