

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Savannah is expected to receive \$800,827 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development in Continuum of Care (CoC) program funds to implement a supportive housing program; and

WHEREAS, the Chatham Savannah Authority for the Homeless, Inc. (CSAH) is a non-profit organization that provides case management services for people experiencing homelessness through its unified case management system and shall serve as the project sponsor and subrecipient; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City Council to authorize the submission of the CoC application to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for FY 2022 funding to implement the Supportive Housing Program known as City 54 which provides rental and utility subsidies for persons living with mental health and substance use disorders.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah, Georgia, hereby authorize the City Manager to submit to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the City's FY 2022 Continuum of Care application and to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding and grant agreement with the subrecipient named therein.
