

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah approved the City's FY2021 One Year Action Plan on October 8, 2020 which allocated \$93,970 in 2021 ESG funds for Homelessness Prevention.

WHEREAS, the City of Savannah seeks to support agencies that can successfully provide services to assist low-to-moderate income persons and carry out a project to provide Homeless Prevention Services to include short-term rent and utility assistance for persons at risk of homelessness.

WHEREAS, Family Promise of the Coastal Empire is a long-standing homeless service provider with more than 20 years of proven experience in managing homeless shelter programs and offering homeless prevention services for Savannah residents.

WHEREAS, the City seeks to enter into a contract with Family Promise of the Coastal Empire, for an amount not to exceed \$93,970 for the provision of Homeless Prevention Services to include short-term rent and utility assistance for persons at risk of homelessness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah authorize the City Manager, to enter into a grant agreement with Family Promise of the Coastal Empire for FY2021 ESG Homelessness Prevention services for program year 2022.
