A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AMEND THE ESTIMATED LINE ITEM ALLOCATION OF THE TIER 4 SPLOST-6 (2014-2020) CITY OF SAVANNAH PROJECT IN THE EVENT TOTAL SPLOST REVENUES EXCEED \$400 MILLION AND MAKE CERTAIN FY19 SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND

**WHEREAS**, the City of Savannah and Chatham County have entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement (the "**IGA**") providing for the allocation of the projected SPLOST 6 revenue among jurisdictions within the County; and

WHEREAS, the IGA provides for the funding of a SPLOST 6 City of Savannah Project in the projected amount of \$190 million to be funded from the first \$370 million of SPLOST proceeds (Tier 1), and further provides for funding in the projected amount of \$15 million for the City of Savannah Project in the event total SPLOST revenues exceed \$385 million (Tier 3), and further provides for funding in the event total SPLOST revenues exceed \$400 million (Tier 4); and

**WHEREAS,** at the regular meeting of the Mayor and Alderman of the City of Savannah, Georgia held on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of September 2013, estimated use of Tier 4 proceeds were duly motioned, seconded and adopted; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to amend the estimated line item allocation of Tier 4 projects; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Savannah desires to make various improvements in support of large scale infrastructure, equipment and development needs in 2019;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Mayor and Alderman of the City of Savannah, Georgia hereby resolve to plan for the estimated line item allocation of projected amounts as follows:
