

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SAVANNAH
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE
GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR A HISTORIC
RESOURCES SURVEY

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and Alderman of the City of Savannah, Georgia, held on the 12th day of September 2019, a motion was made, duly seconded, and unanimously adopted that the City of Savannah authorizes the execution of a grant contract with the Georgia Department of Natural Resources to update the historic resources survey of the Cuyler-Brownsville during Savannah Citywide Historic Neighborhood Survey, Phase III Part B.

NOW THEREFORE, The grant budget is \$17,000 with \$6,800 awarded by the federal Historic Preservation Fund which is matched in cash by the City with \$3,944 and Historic Savannah Foundation with \$2,686. The project budget includes an in-kind contribution of \$3,570 for project management staff support. The project will be conducted in partnership with the Metropolitan Planning Commission.
