

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Savannah has received notification from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development that it may apply for two FY2019 HOPWA Competitive Renewal grants totaling \$921,208; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Mayor and Aldermen to authorize the City Manager to submit a renewal application for federal assistance, on behalf of project sponsor Union Mission, Inc. in the amount of \$671,776 to implement the project known as Project House Call- Renewal #7; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Mayor and Aldermen to authorize the City Manager to submit a renewal application for federal assistance, on behalf of project sponsor Union Mission, Inc. in the amount of \$249,432 to implement the project known as Daniel-Flagg Villas-Renewal #6.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah, Georgia, hereby authorize the City Manager to submit the aforementioned grant applications and to enter into agreements with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and with the project sponsor to provide permanent supportive housing for low-income persons living with HIV/AIDS.
