RESOLUTION REVOKING DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY TO MAKE AND EXECUTE CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, Section 3-110 of the City Charter vests authority and power to make and execute contracts in the City Manager; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-108(9) of the City Charter provides that the City Manager has the right to recommend to Council for its adoption such measures as he or she may deem necessary or expedient; and

WHEREAS, on February 2, 2017, pursuant to Sections 3-110 and 3-108(9) of the City Charter, the Mayor and Aldermen authorized the City Manager to delegate the authority to make and execute contracts to certain executive level staff; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Aldermen reserved the right to revoke said resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah, Georgia hereby resolve as follows:

The authorization permitting the City Manager to delegate authority to make and execute contracts embodied in a Resolution dated February 2, 2017 is hereby REVOKED. As of the date of this Resolution, no City employee, apart from the City Manager, may make or execute contracts on behalf of the City of Savannah.
